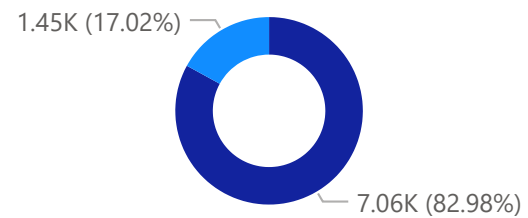

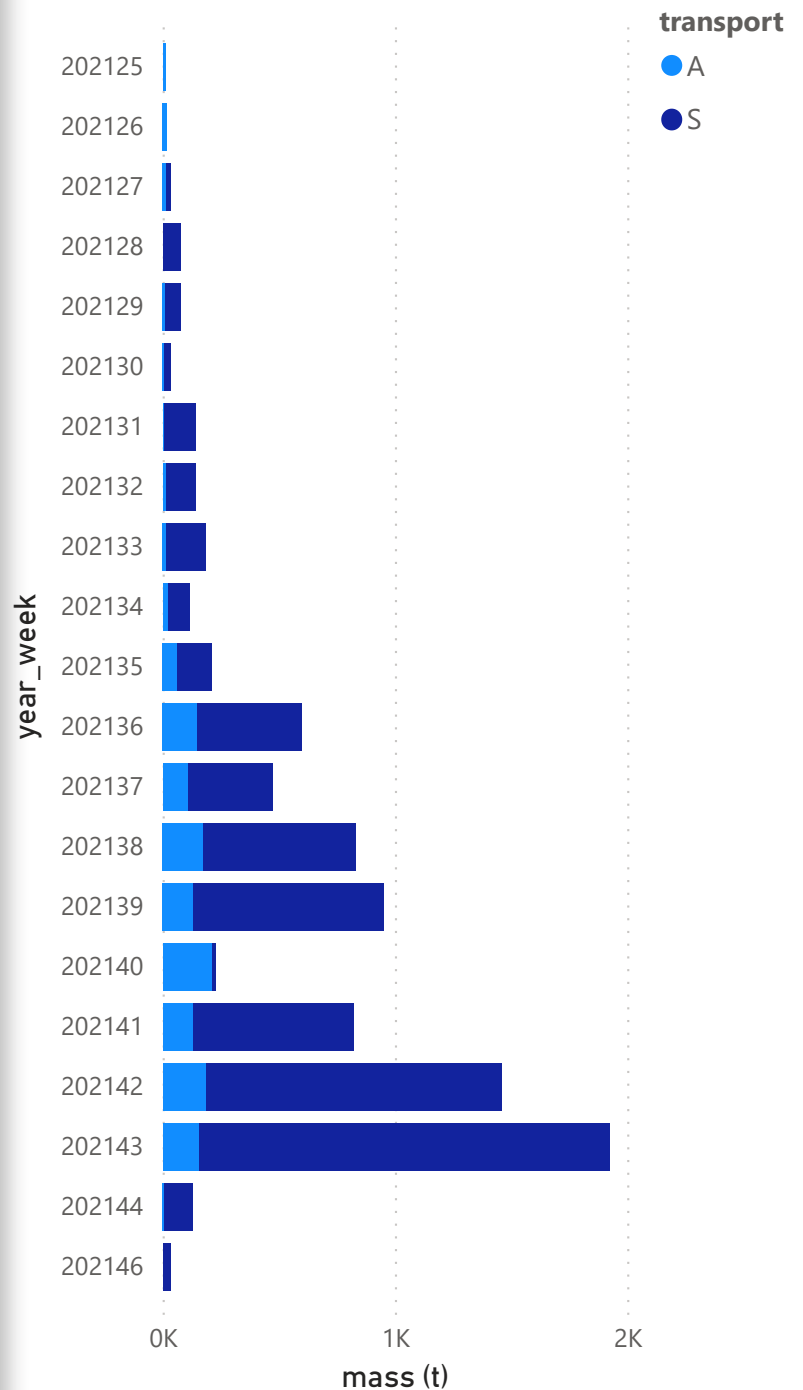

Tonne by week



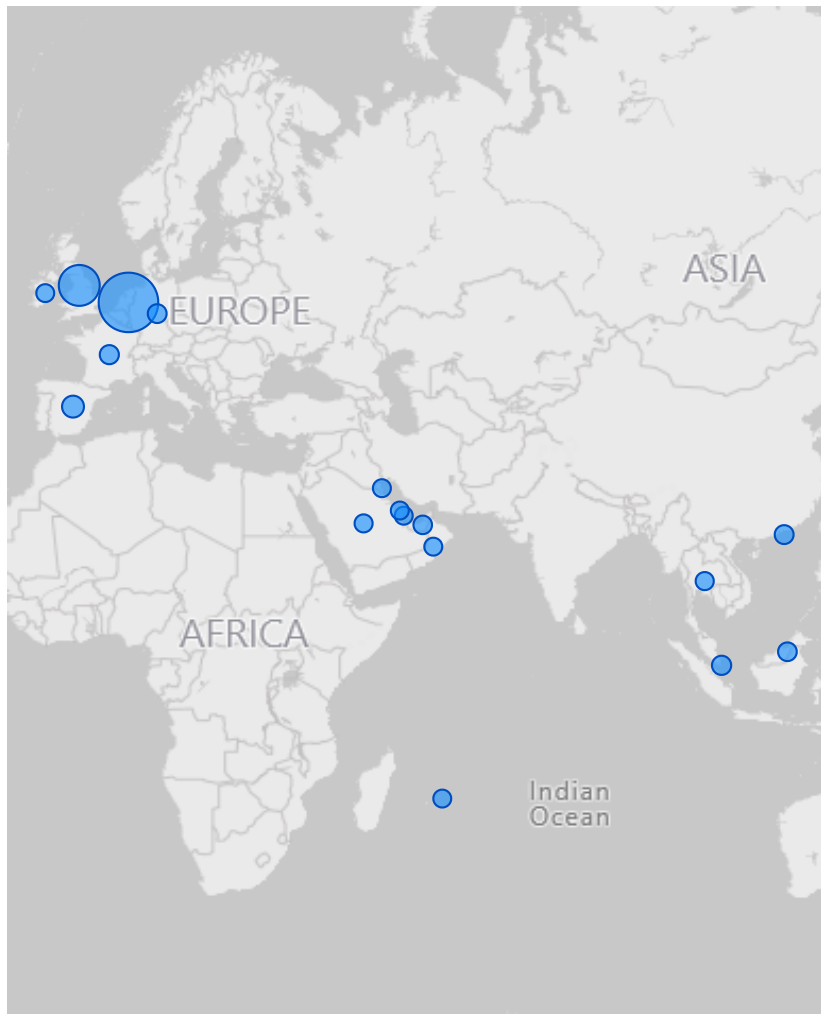

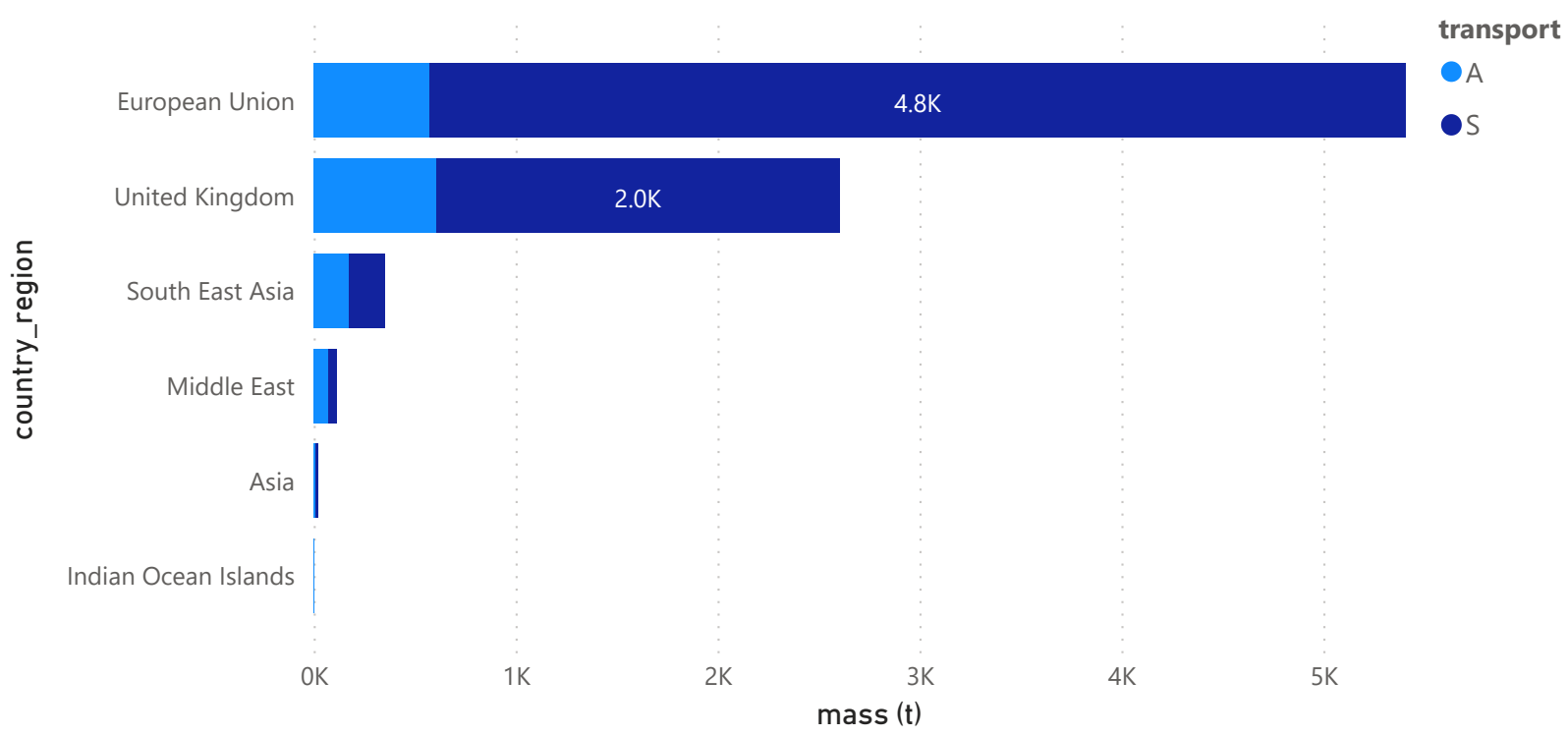
